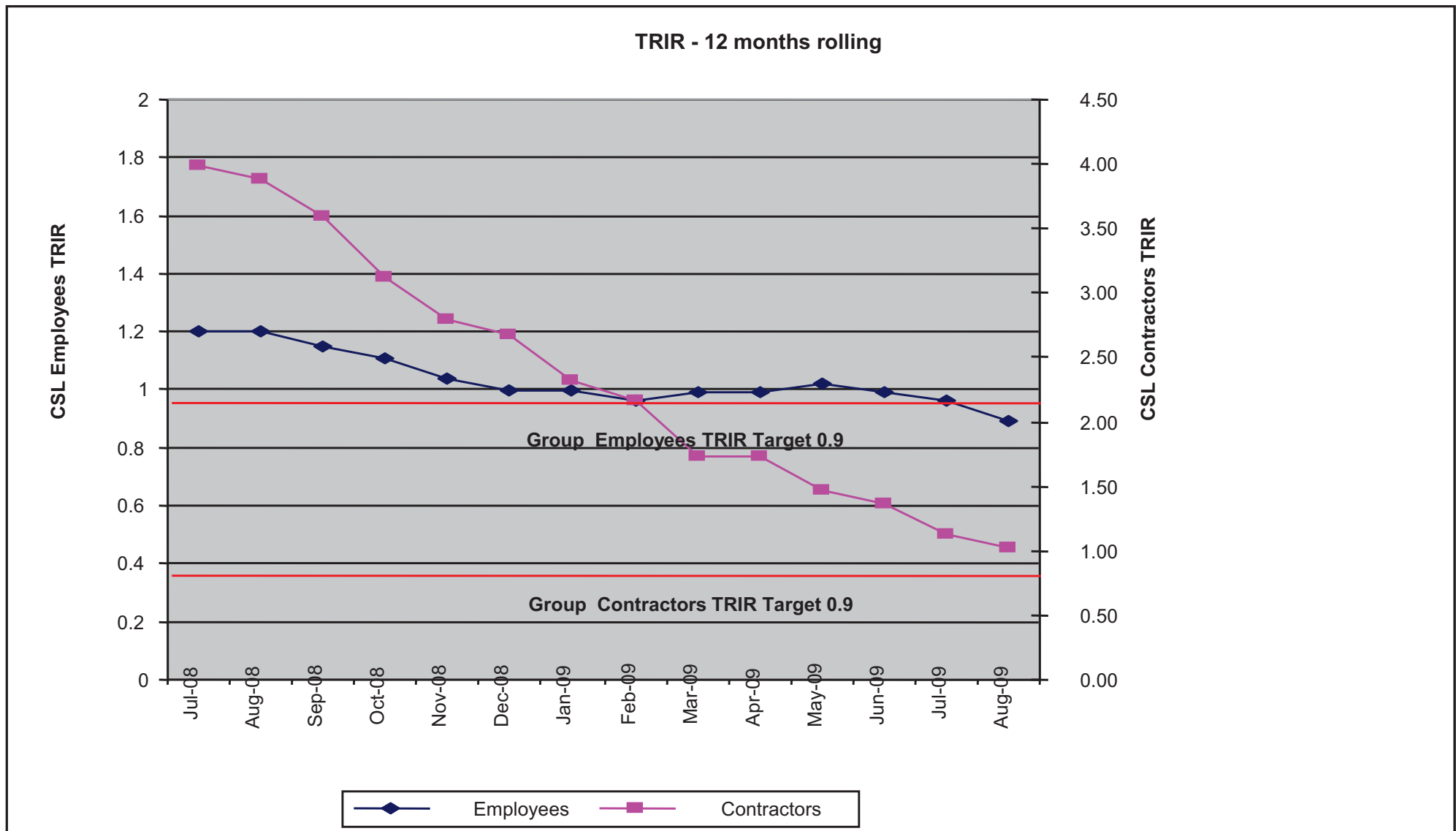

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History

- Established in 1946, in Johannesburg
- Supply 'high quality chemicals' supported by application know-how
- Manufacturing began in Johannesburg in 1948, after a 1947 visit to secure technology
- Rapid expansion and factories started in Durban, Cape Town and PE
- Chloorkop factory established in 1955
- Listed in 1967 as Chemical Holdings - 9 subsidiaries, 3 JVs
- 1980: Chemical Holdings became a subsidiary of AECI
- 1983: Reverted to Chemical Services
- By 1986: R100m turnover and R6.3m PBT



History cont.

- 2001: Chemserve acquired several AECI companies including CI, Duco, Industrial Urethanes and Resinkem
- 2003: AECI acquired 100% stake in Chemserve, Chemserve de-listed from the JSE
- 2006: R4.8bn turnover. Investment in Brazil
- 2007: Initiated mining capital expansion
- 2008: Achieved R8bn sales. Commenced capital program
- 2009: Managed aftershocks of the global meltdown
Commenced commissioning of new capacity

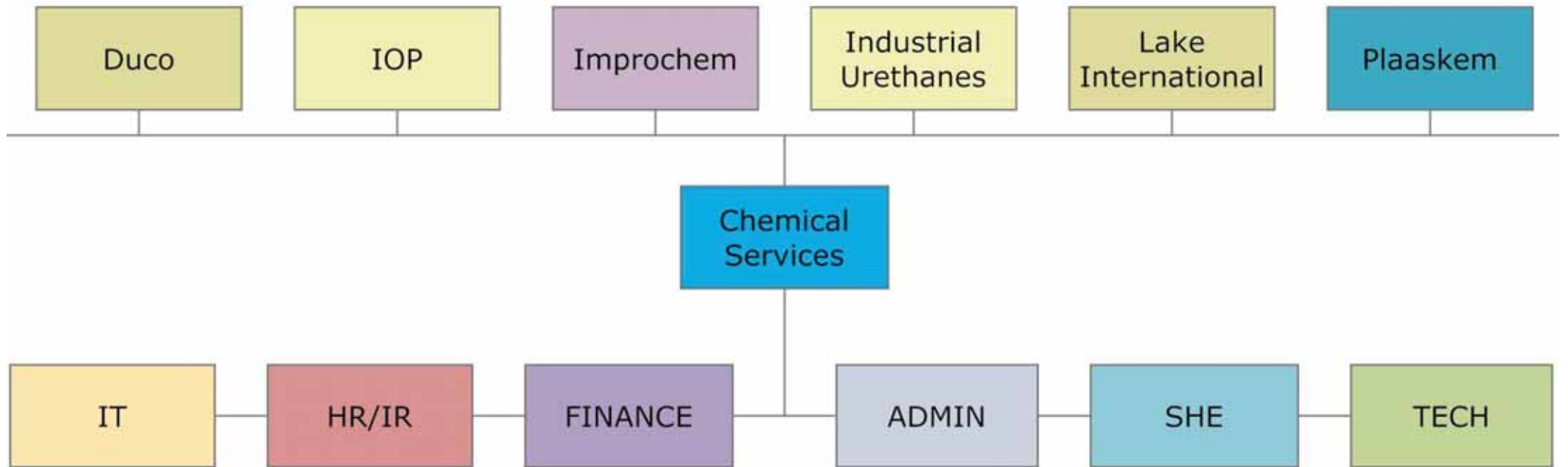

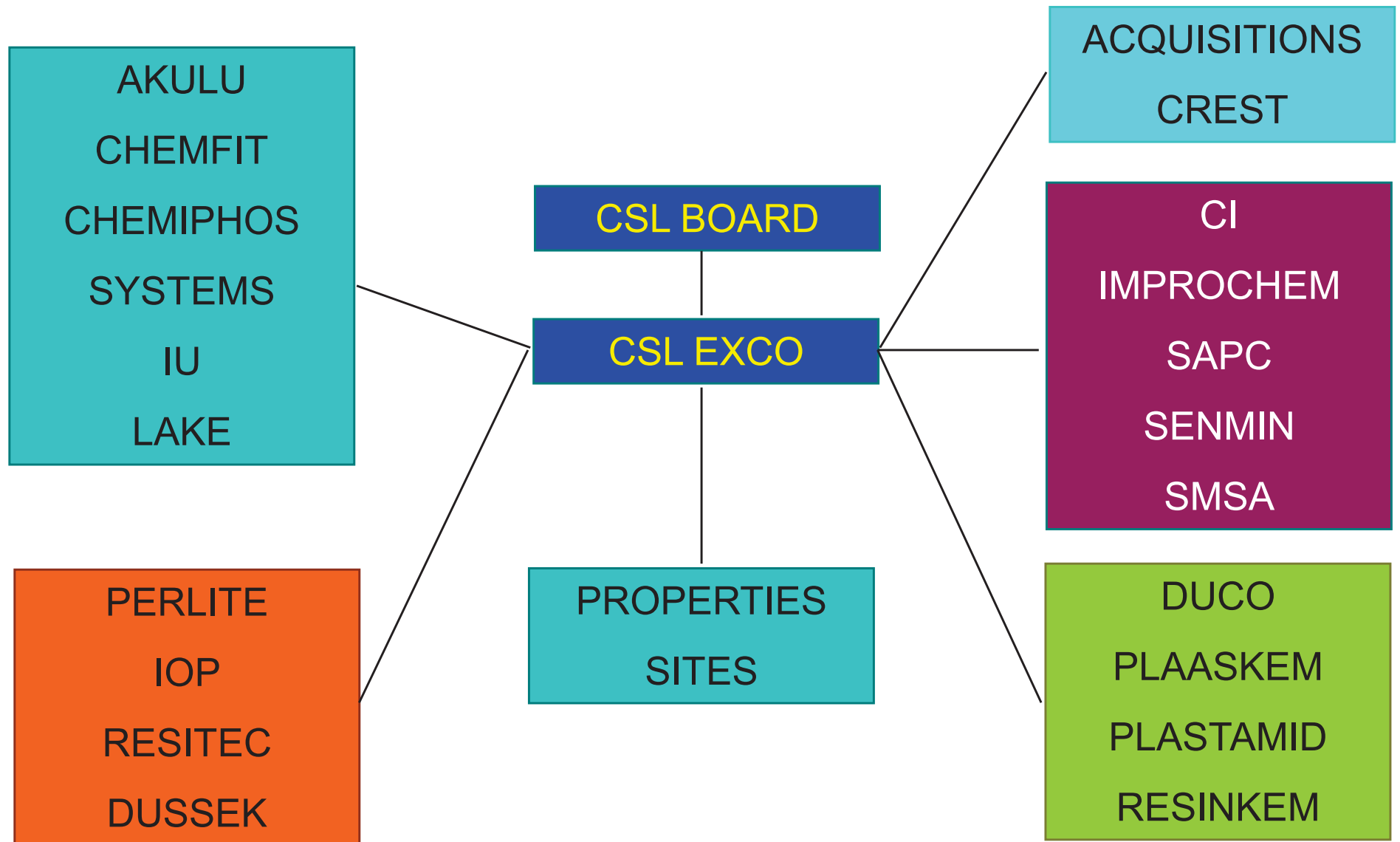

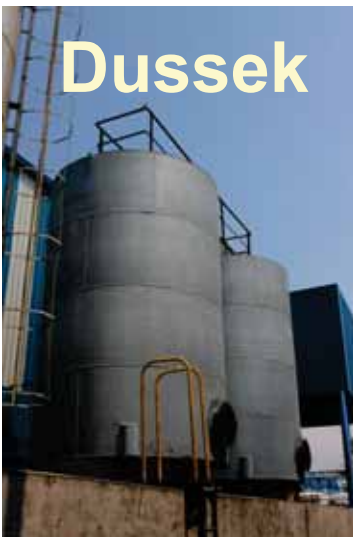


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Chemserve today: 2 125 people and 20 companies

Smaller companies



- Perlite is in a good space with food, wine, cryogenics
- Plastamid down with automotive, and loss of textile fibre waste
- Dussek slow in line with construction
- Smaller company revenue = 1.5% of total



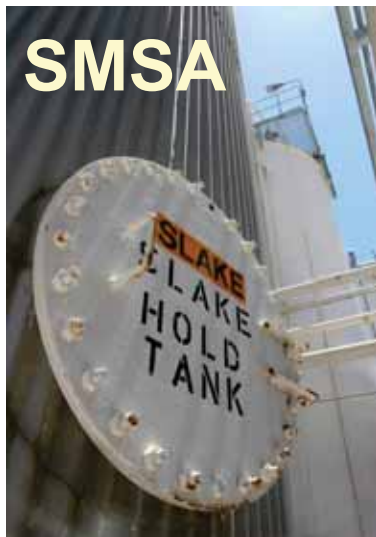
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Small companies

Resitec



SMSA



- Resitec poised for growth in recovering Brazilian market, and new fractionation products
- Duco drastically restructured to a service and logistics company
- SMSA at medium rates in line with paper industry



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Small companies



- Chemiphos steady in phosphoric acids, and making progress in construction chemicals
- Chemfit slowing with markets, good prospects in feeds and soil sterilisation
- Small company revenue = 13% of total



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Medium companies



- SAPC not stretched at current paper industry volumes
- IOP reasonably loaded with diverse markets including mining and coatings
- Resinkem idling in line with board industry



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Medium companies



- CS Systems volumes down with foundry, plastics, heavy industry
- IU down with drop in white goods, mining, and manufacturing
- Plaaskem gearing up for '09 season



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Medium companies



- CI dealing with collapse of the sulphur market and a difficult acid balance in '09. Good Tigersul introduction
- Akulu detergent market slow but busy in personal care; battling in export market with strong Rand. New facility up and running well
- Medium company revenue = 43% of total



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Large companies



- Crest on a roll with the recent successful acquisition of CH Chemicals
- ImproChem solid with service model and several steady markets



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Large companies



- Senmin value add model growing successfully
- Projects reaching completion

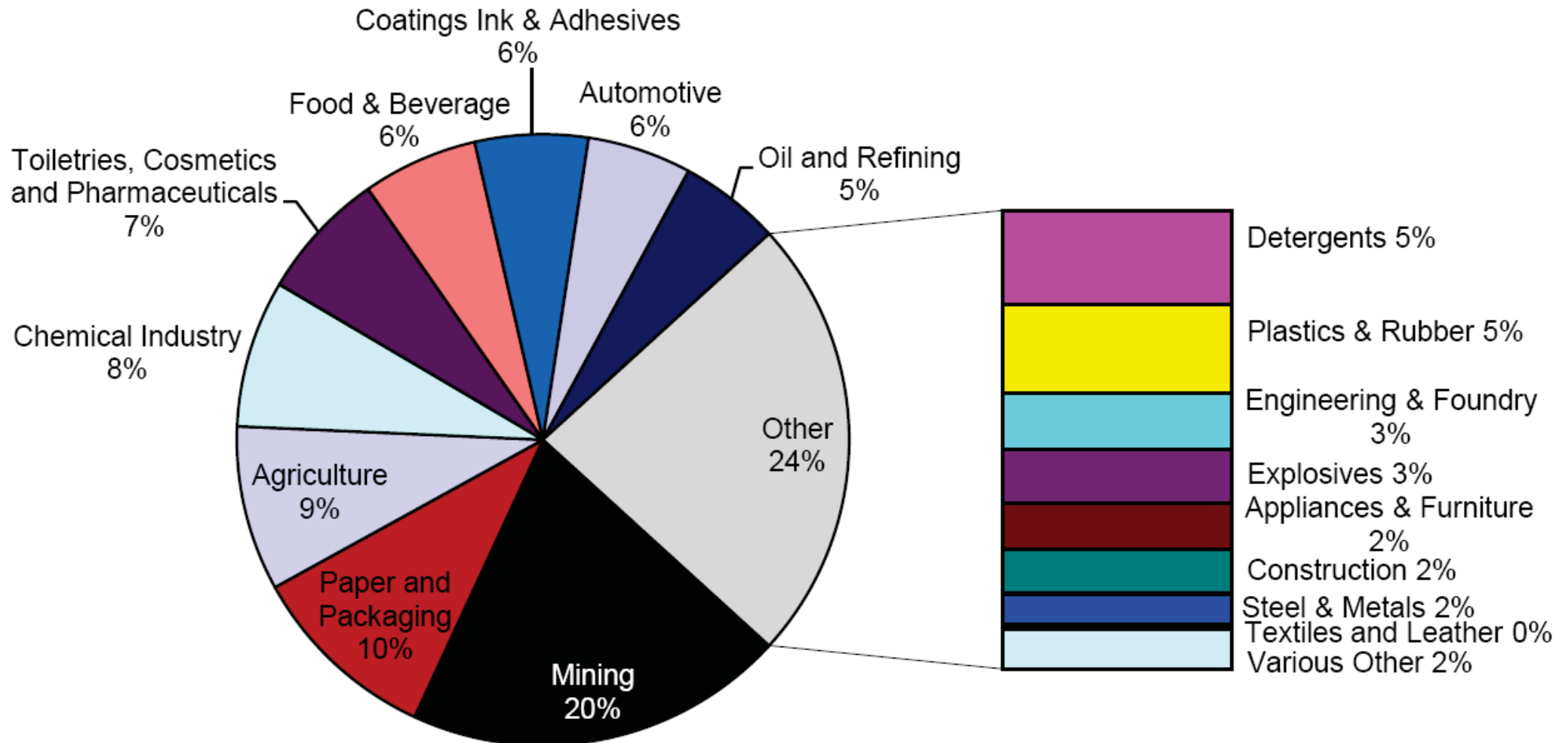


- Lake growing rapidly in food, explosive emulsions, and specialty granule dust suppression and attachment products

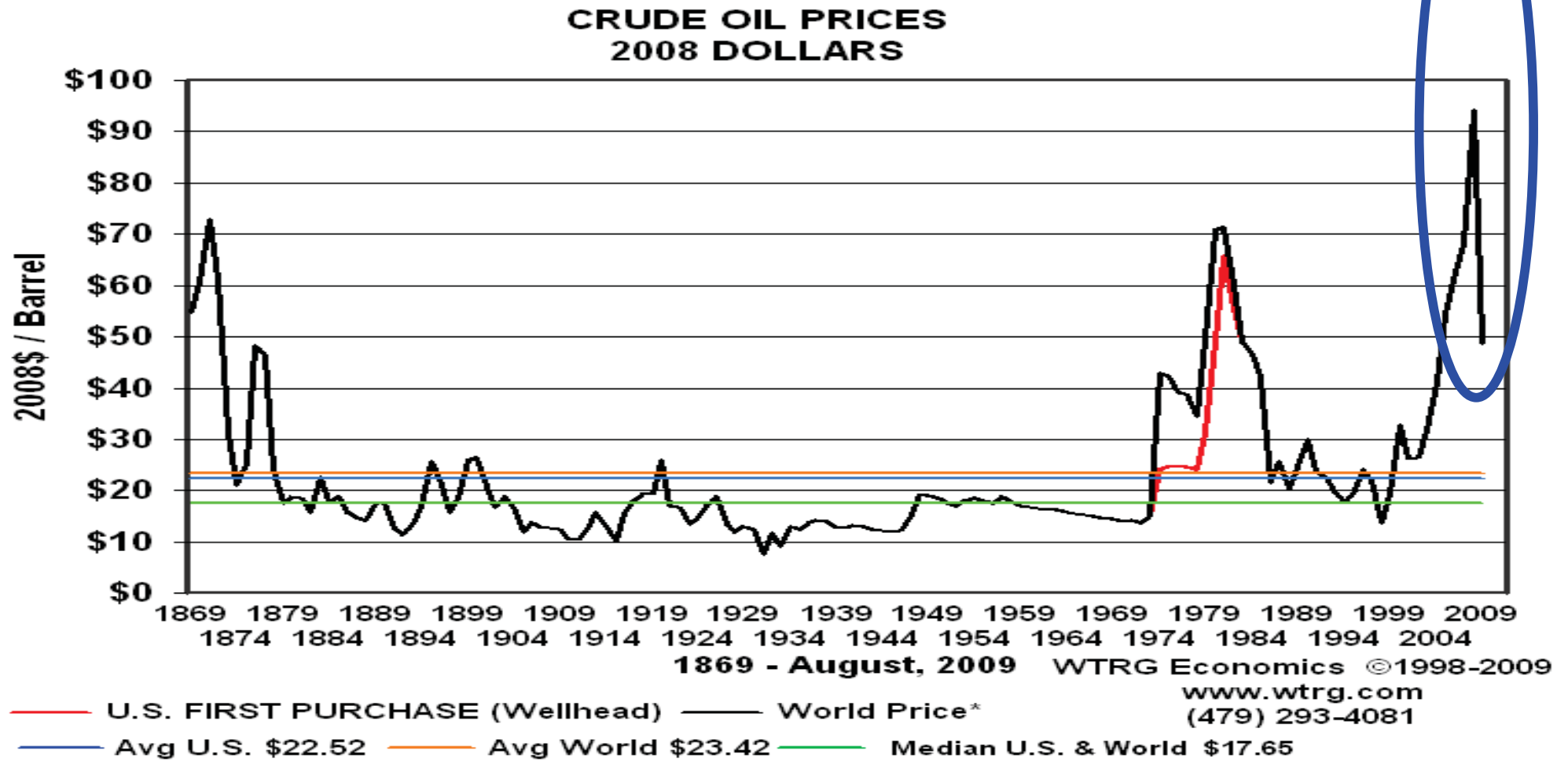

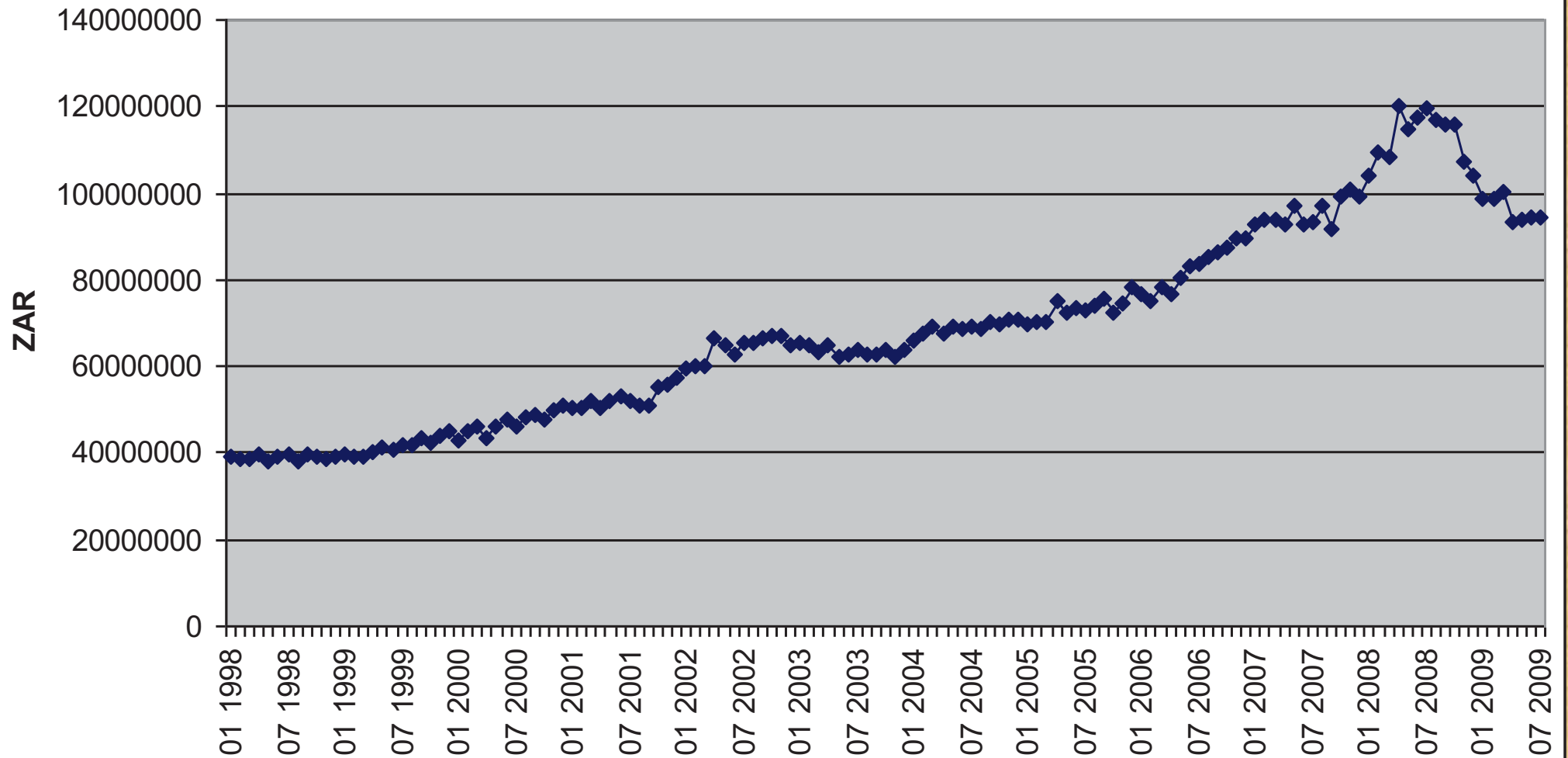


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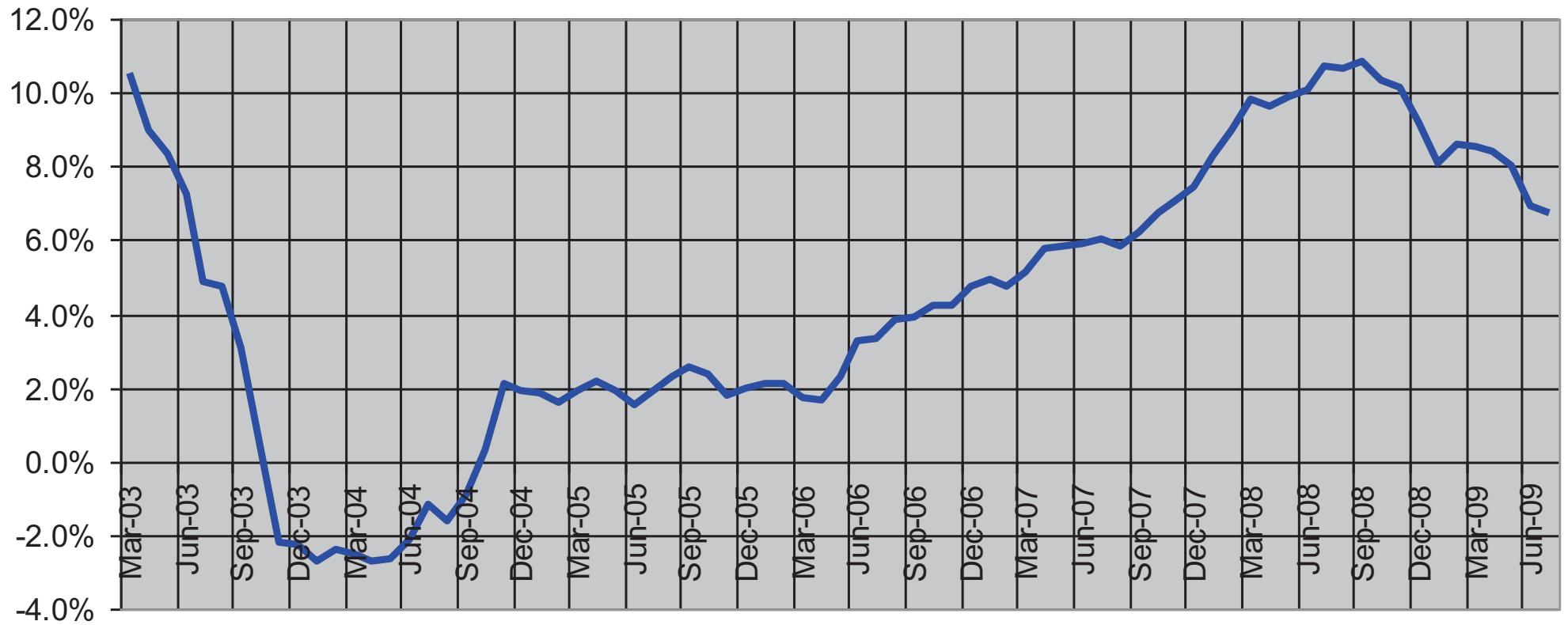
SA manufacturing sales

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Historical performance

- Trade working capital reduction 1H09 R458m



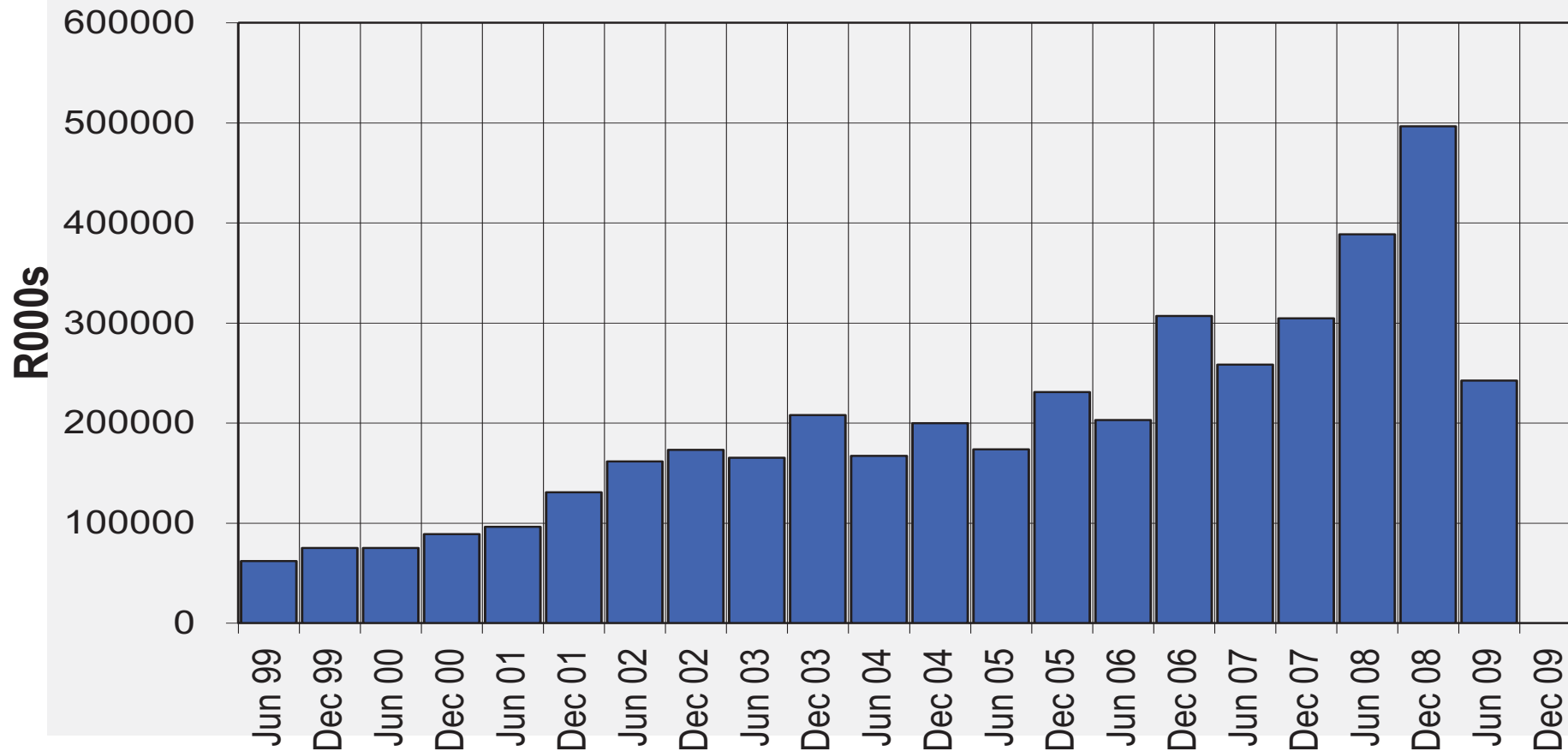
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Trading profit by half-year

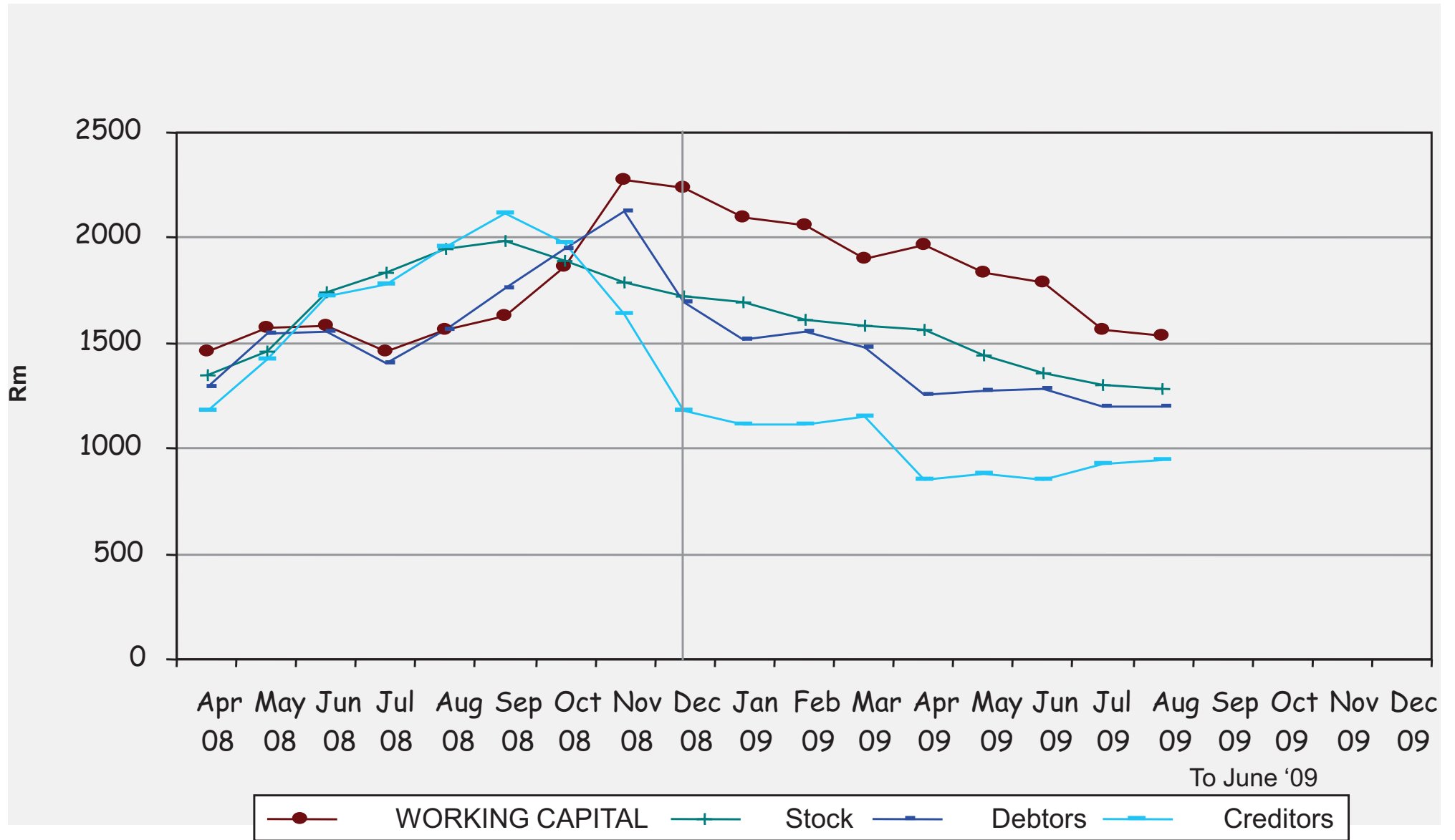
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CHEMICAL SERVICES TRADING PROFIT

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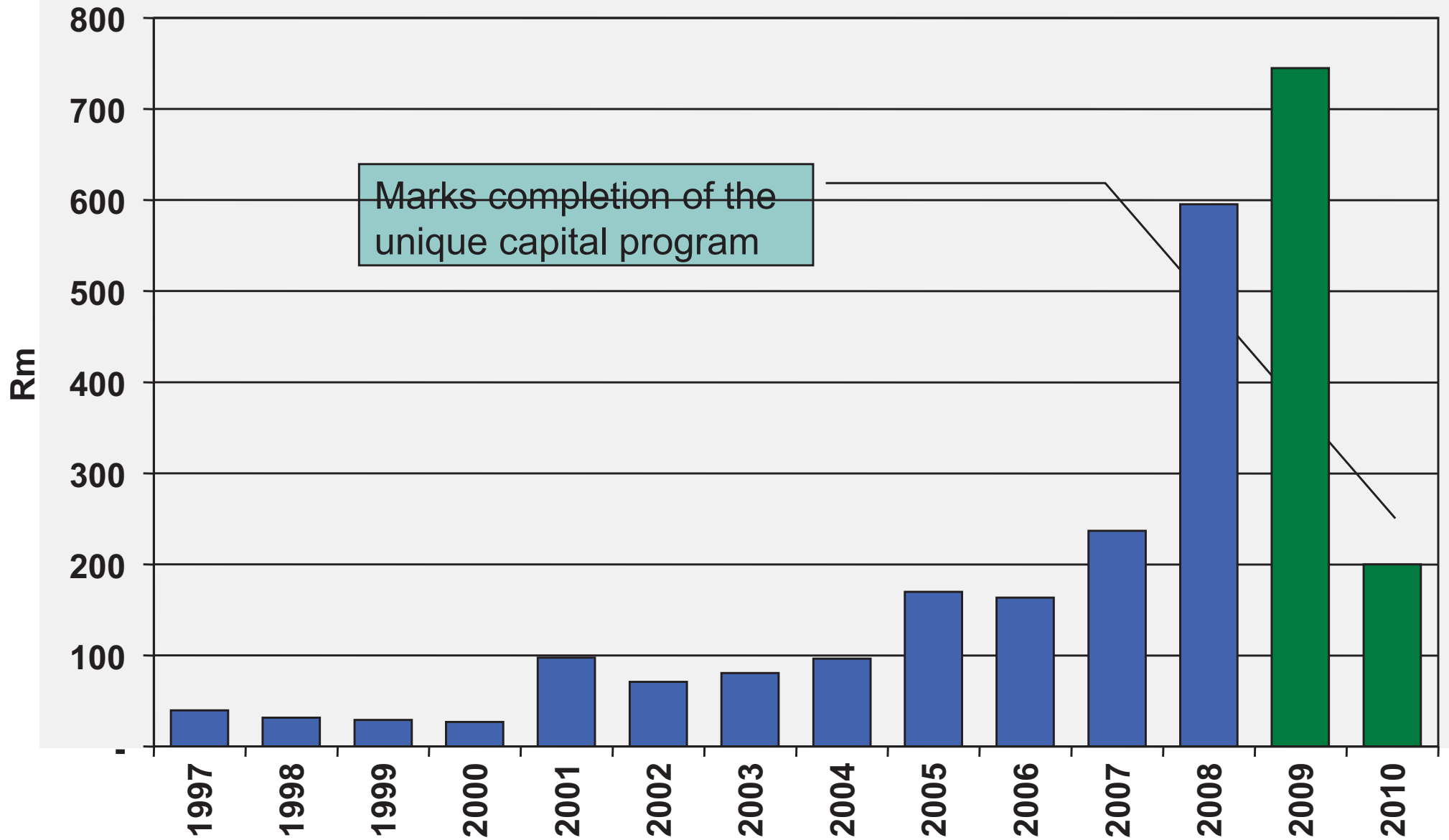

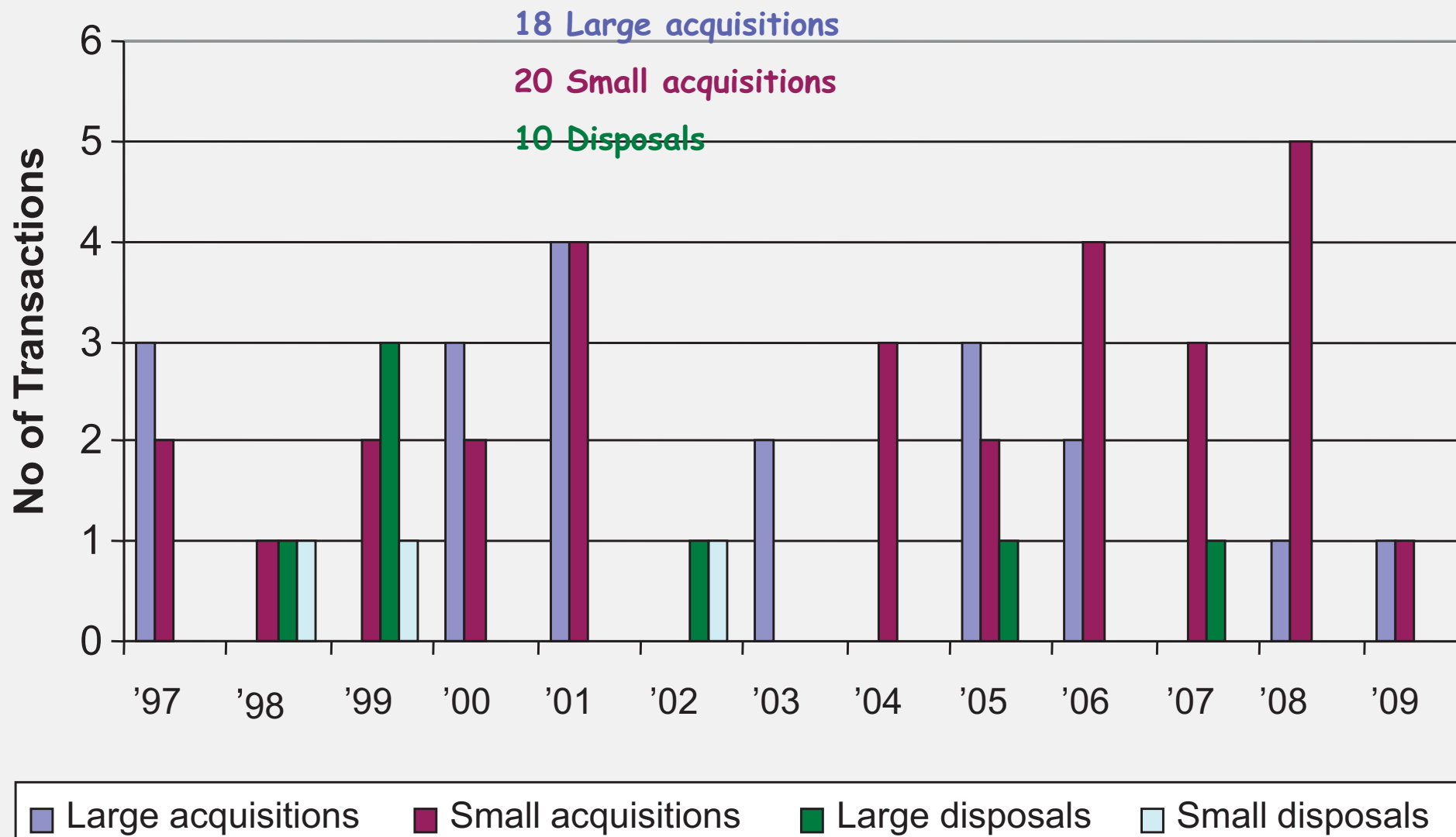

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Update 2009

- Acquisition of 80% of Cobito by Lake
- Acquisition of CH Chemicals by Crest
- Exit of CSL Epping site for more suitable premises in Epping, and sale of site
- Cessation of paint manufacture at Duco, Port Elizabeth, and sale of site
- Purchase of Senmin land
- Consolidation onto Chloorkop Site of :
 - IU Sebenza site
 - Akulu Wynberg site
 - Plastamid warehousing
- 1H mark-to-market of stock and export debtors



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Update 2009 cont.

- Commercialisation of new guar capacity
- Xanthates I and II: construction and commissioning
- Fractionation column: construction and commissioning
- Sulphonation units: construction and commissioning
- CS₂ plant: construction and commissioning
- Acrylamide plant: construction and bio-lab commissioning
- PAM plant: construction



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Outlook

- '05 management target pushed out by 12 – 18 months
- Very strong Rand will expose SA cost base in manufacturing and mining and delay recovery
- Chemserve cost base has been trimmed
- Impact of projects will start to be felt in '10
- Green shoots more evident in mining than manufacturing
- Trading profit margin will recover to above historical levels



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
